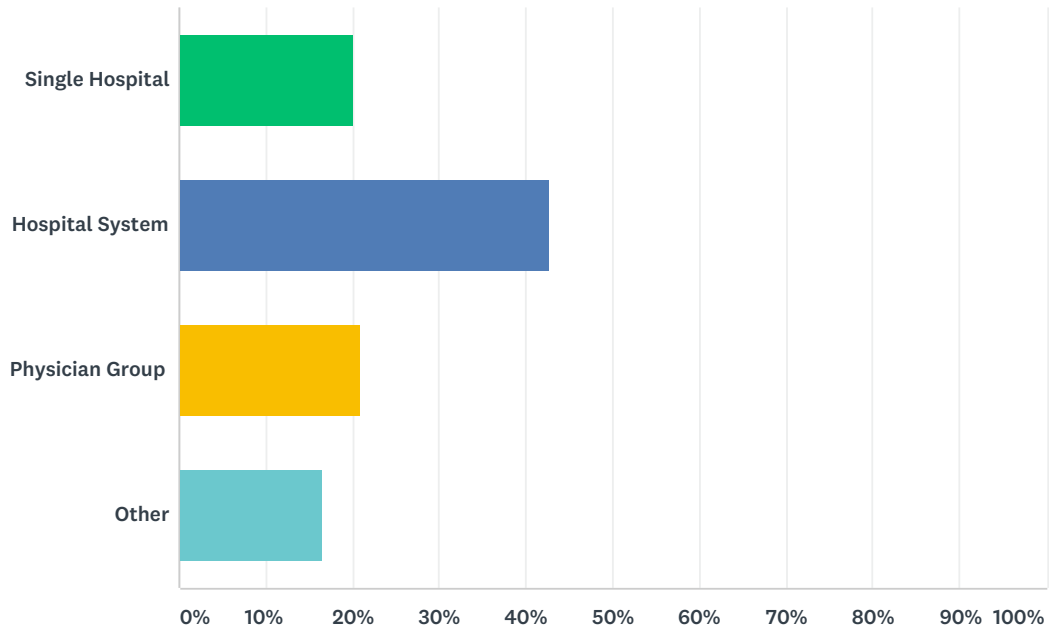


## Q1 What type of provider are you?

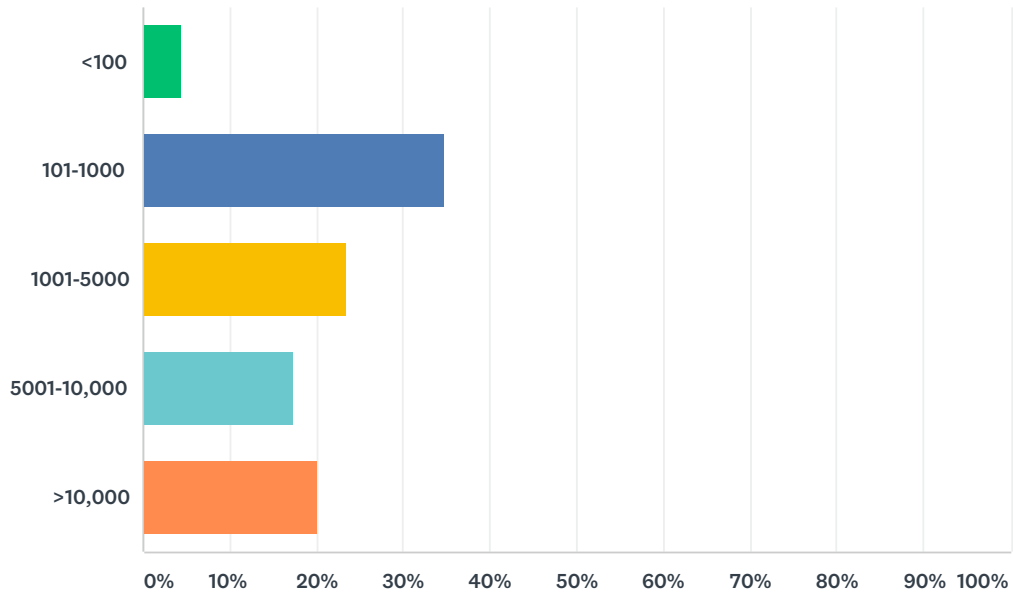

## Q2 How many employees do you have?

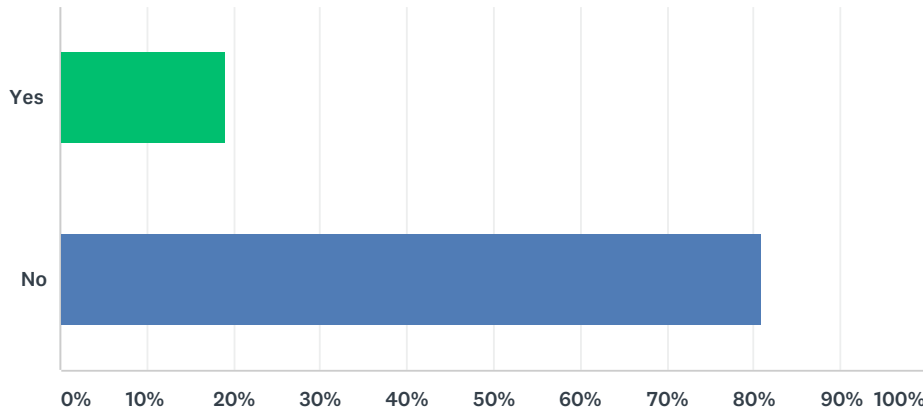

### Q3 Do you allow your employees and/or providers (physicians/ARNP/PA) to access their own medical records stored within your EMR?

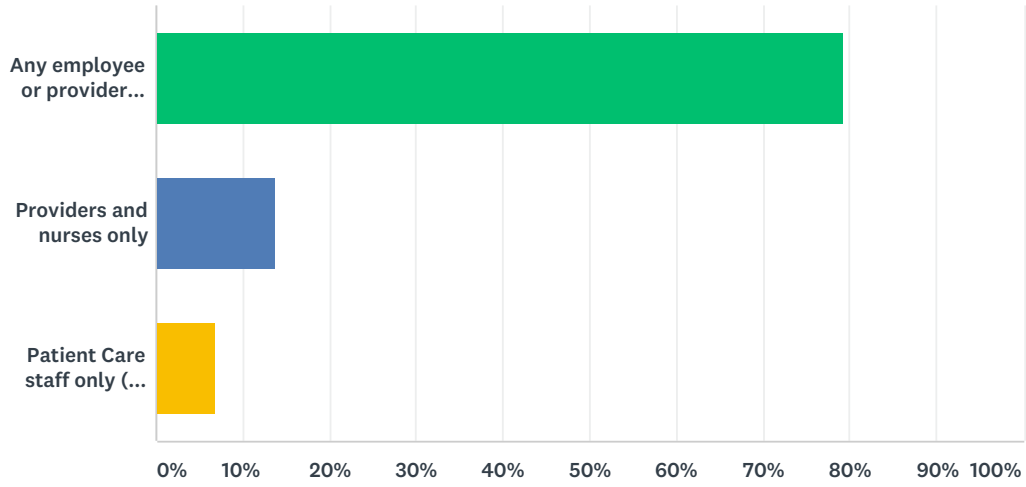

## Q4 If yes, who may access their own records?

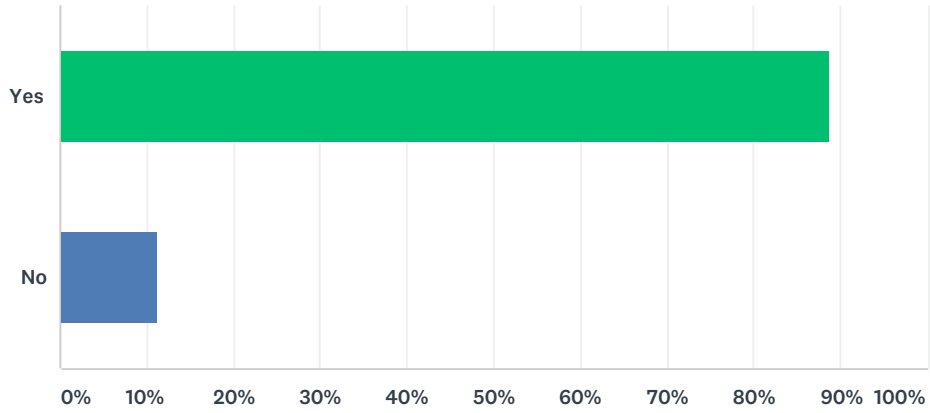

### Q5 Do you have a patient portal?

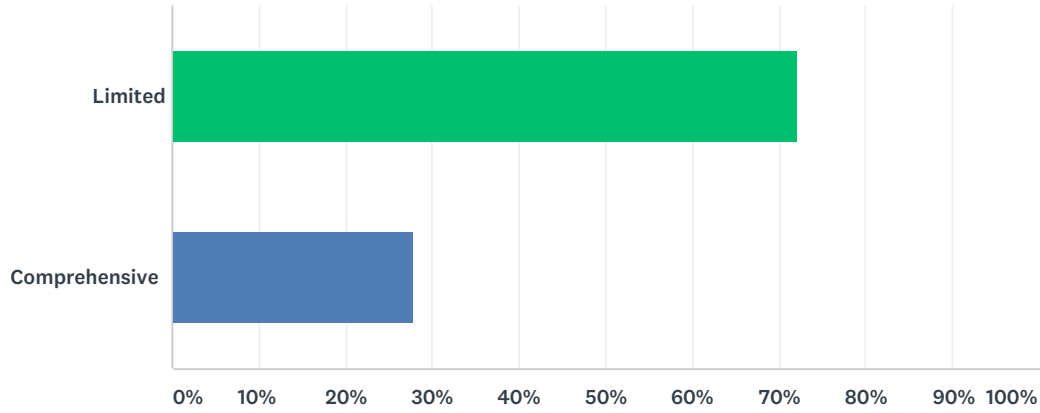
